Since firmware version 10.1.22.0, Snom uses the **Mozilla CA Certificate List** for its desktop phones.



When a new firmware version is built, we always use the **Mozilla Included CA Certificate List** from that day.

View list of installed certificates

To view the currently supported certificates of the Snom Desktop phone you are using,

- go to > **Certificates/Preinstalled Certificates**
